EU Horizon 2020 funded Jan 2017 – Dec 2019

Core objective is for the promotion and innovation of European Agroforestry;

Taking our research into the field

AFINET RAIN is not a field based programme

Our RAIN groups will be designed to share and communicate information on practical measures to encourage innovation

As a result we have identified a requirement for additional field labs

A field lab should be designed to take research into practice

Providing real time solutions to overcome real time problems

Establishing a field lab takes time and resource

Two avenues of funding, European Innovation Partnership (EIP-Agri) and through Innovative Farmers (IF)





European Innovation Partnership

EIP-Agri provides support for innovative projects that improve agricultural productivity and sustainability

Linking research with farming or forestry practices

Projects and research must focus on recognised industry problems

Funding can be up to 100% of costs of £5-£150k over 3 years for operational groups

Applicants must register outline project <300 words

Applications are lengthy, costs are claimed post delivery





Innovative Farmers

Innovative Farmers is an initiative designed to encourage farmers to find new ways of growing better food, cutting waste, improving profit margins

Innovative Farmers is funded by the Duchy Future Farming Programme backed by SA, ORC, IFA and LEAF

Exchanging ideas, developing new tools and techniques in practical 'field labs'

Funding application for up to £10k is fairly straightforward

To compliment our work under AFINET we are proposing to develop an Agroforestry Field Lab – but we need your help!...
