






SOLID

- Total budget ~ 6 million euros
- 5 years
- 25 partners (11 SMEs)
- 10 countries





SOLID Objectives

- To optimise competitiveness in innovative organic and low input dairy supply chains while:
 - Maximising the potential of these systems to deliver environmental goods and biodiversity
 - Developing economic, agronomic and nutritional advantages for organic and low input dairy systems and supply chains in the future




Sustainable Organic and Low Input Dairying (SOLID) Project

- Research approach bringing together scientists and innovative practitioners from the dairy supply chain
- Technological development of novel strategies for production
- Evaluation of novel strategies from an environmental and socio-economic perspective
- Recommendations regarding potential of organic and low input dairy systems to meet multifunctional needs of agriculture in Europe












SOLID Activities

- 1. Actively involve stakeholders (organic and low input dairy farmers, farmer groups, advisors, processors) in a co-ordinated participatory approach
- 2. Quantify advantages of genotypes "adapted to organic and low input dairy production systems"
- Novel and sustainable feed resources and decision support model to optimise management of on-farm feed
- 4. A knowledge platform to assess environmental sustainability





SOLID Activities

- 5. Identify the broad range of expectations of low-input and organic dairy farming and food systems
- 6. Evaluate the competitiveness of existing organic and low input dairy farms and novel strategies developed
- 7. Disseminate knowledge to key stakeholders through a participatory framework
