### Food Sovereignty: embeds the Right to Food

"Food sovereignty includes the Right to Food – the right of peoples to healthy and culturally appropriate food produced through socially just and ecologically sensitive methods"







## Food Sovereignty Framework What it stands for | What it opposes 6 Pillars

- 1. Focuses on Food for People and the Right to Food, rather than industrial commodities
- 2. Values Food Providers and respects Farmers' Rights, rather than squeezing them off the land and destroying their seeds
- 3. Localises Food Systems, rather than unfair global trade
- 4. Puts Control Locally, rather than by distant TNCs
- 5. Builds Knowledge and Skills of real farmers, rather than remote science and GMOs
- 6. Works with Nature in ecological production, rather than chemically-intensive monocultures
